# A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

At the Last Supper, before he offers himself on the Cross for the salvation of the world, Jesus gathers together his friends at table, and sums up what he had always done for them and all the people; he shares himself.

The disciples likely did not understand what was taking place nor understand what Jesus was telling them. However, the disciples and through them the Church, that is us, were now fully joined with Christ and his mission of bringing salvation to all humanity.

The message of Jesus at the table of the Last Supper as he gathered with his disciples is that the promise of God was nearly fulfilled. The friendship of God with humanity was about to be restored by his death on the Cross and the kingdom of Christ established.

In the Last Supper, all of Jesus' ministry comes to together and gives shape to the disciples' task and that of the Church, our task, in building up the kingdom of heaven.

When we celebrate the Eucharist each Sunday, each day, we remember the historical life of Jesus and look to the future with hope in expectation of the banquet of eternal life in kingdom of heaven, sharing in God's eternal friendship and love.

In the Eucharist, Christ continues to share himself with us that we may one day rejoice at that eternal banquet. In turn he expects us to invite others to share in that banquet.

This is what Christ expects of his followers that they share themselves with others as his body the Church. He calls his followers to be servants in his image of inviter and servant. At the Last Supper he is prefiguring his role as host and servant at the messianic banquet. At this eternal banquet his disciples and servants will enjoy the hospitality of God.

Whenever we gather at the Lord's Table, we are entering into solidarity not only with those gathered with us, but also with all the suffering, poor, needy, and sick. If we are to be truly faithful to Christ command at the Last Supper, we are committing to share ourselves with them, to walk with them, that together we may recognize the Lord's presence among at the Eucharist table of the Lord.



# GIVE USTODAY: PALM SUNDAY



"WHERE DO YOU WANT US TO PREPARE FOR YOU TO EAT THE PASSOVER?"

Matthew 26:17

We do not have to be concerned about that question. We know where we will be eating today. This is a Palm Sunday like no other that I can remember. It's Palm-less! But that doesn't mean we do not celebrate the gift that Jesus gave us that night. He prepared a meal like no other! He offered

himself so that we could live. Those gathered with him had no idea what was ahead for them. We too never know what the next moment will bring. Without warning we are left startled saying "Wow, I didn't see that coming!" Just as the crowds saw Jesus coming to celebrate shouting "Hosanna!" waiving palms to welcome him into the city, the same crowds witnessed and even encouraged the crucifixion shortly afterward. On this day of celebration and sadness, take the time to be thankful for all that Jesus has done for us. During Holy Week, take the time to go through the Stations of the Cross. Holy Week reminds us that it is possible to create something new within ourselves. The cross of Christ teaches us that there is victory over evil! "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord."

# FIVE SIMPLE WAYS TO CELEBRATE HOLY WEEK AT HOME

Create a simple prayer space in your home, and gather there to pray during the week. Palm Sunday: At your regular Mass time, read the first Palm Sunday Gospel (Mt 21:1–11) and meditate on or discuss what Jesus might be thinking as he enters Jerusalem for the last time. Holy Thursday: Bake bread for sharing at dinner; make a ritual of stripping the dinner table of all cloths and decorations after dinner.

Good Friday: Pray the Stations of the Cross at 3 p.m.

Holy Saturday: In the morning, read Psalm 64 and break your Good Friday fast solemnly with a simple meal.

Easter Sunday: Dress up the dinner table again. Include candles and crosses, so that the candy baskets aren't the only festive items present. Sing Alleluia and read the Easter Gospel (Matthew 28:1-10) with solemnity and joy.



# A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

After his resurrection Christ appeared to Mary of Magdala, Peter and his disciples. He also appeared to two of his disciples, Cleopas, and his companion. They were traveling the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus. They were running from the events that had occurred in Jerusalem, they were trying to escape after Christ's crucifixion, because they did not understand what had taken place. They had not listened attentively to the words of Jesus while he taught them and sat with them at various tables breaking bread with them.

They did not recognize Christ in their presence, because they had not been attentive to his words and failed to grasp that he had to suffer on the Cross, die, and rise to restore God's proper and good relationship with humanity. He was a stranger to them.

And so, he begins again to call Cleopas and his companion into discipleship by inviting them to listen attentively to his words. These words, we know are words of forgiveness, reconciliation, and inner conversion. Christ, the Lord of compassion, the **R**isen Lord, invites them to walk again with him.

After he explained to them the Scriptures, they were opened to receiving Christ once again into their hearts and friendship. They invite him to join them at table and to break bread with them

But, the Risen Lord instead becomes once again the host and servant at "the breaking of the bread" and the two disciples now being properly disposed to recognize Jesus as the Messiah.

As he broke bread with them their hearts were open, a deep conversion took place within them that once again empowered them as Jesus' disciples to proclaim Christ as the Messiah.

Disappearing from their sight, they, symbolically representing all the disciples and Church; were sent to continue Christ's mission of revealing a God who wants to sit at table with all humanity in peace, joy, and friendship.




# HE IS RISEN GIVE US TODAY

In addition to those served above, 222 individuals from Oak Lawn have received direct emergency assistance.


