

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Each spring and summer as of late, we have seen some heavy rains. I watched as the rains came down as sheets, my weather station actually reads: "It's raining cats and dogs," the work of whoever programmed the computer chip in the weather station. My dog Jerome doesn't like heavy rain and runs straight into the doghouse. Nicholas runs all through the heavy rain, the puddles and the mud.

In today's Gospel passage, we see Christ calming Peter and the Apostles as they encounter the night time seas. Faith in God whether in the calm seas of life or the rough waters that we all experience will bring us safely ashore to dry ground; but, we must trust in the Lord and like St. Peter when we find ourselves sinking, let the Lord take us by the hand.



Just about a year ago Dan Smith called our parish inquiring about adult baptism. Dan and his sponsor met with me weekly until the pandemic hit. Dan was to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil in April. Dan experienced Lent like no other I have known. He worried about whether or not he was worthy of receiving the sacraments, he wondered if this was God's way of saying he shouldn't become Catholic and he learned to pray and trust that God's grace is opened to all. Dan will be receiving the sacraments this coming week. Please pray for him as he now believes that he is ready for the journey ahead as he will be officially initiated as a member of the Catholic Church on August 23<sup>rd</sup>.



#### **Financial Update**

Since COVID-19 hit, there have been a lot of changes to the way Our Lady at St. Germaine Parish operates. Mass has gone online to accommodate those who can't attend or do not feel safe. In person masses have had a schedule change, and only gather at the St. Germaine campus at this time. Sunday collections declined at the beginning of the pandemic but have returned to average projections.

Since the new fiscal year started July 1, 2020:

\$28,334.00 has been mailed in

\$34,683.00 has been collected at masses

\$13,676.00 has been collected through Give Central

The parish carnival had to be cancelled, leaving a projected \$40,000.00 profit lost. The rectory staff has been decreased to the bare minimum, decreasing parish payroll \$66,000.00. Even with that reduction, the church projected deficit is \$33,752.00. The school projected deficit is \$121,567.00. The total parish combined deficit today is \$155,319.00.

There are still capital projects that have not been included in that number. The church roof at St. Germaine campus needs to be replaced at a cost estimate of \$185,000.00. The boiler also needs to be repaired at a cost of \$4,183.00. Property sales at both campuses are still pending and proving to be difficult.

Thank you for your continued sacrifice and support at this most difficult time, financially, emotionally and spiritually.

# Worshipers targeted by gift card scam

July 29, 2019

We're seeing a new spin on gift card scams. This time, scammers are pretending to be a pastor, rabbi, priest, imam, or bishop. They're asking worshipers for gift card contributions for a worthy cause. Appeals are often made by email, but we've heard people are also getting texts and phone calls, too.

The bogus emails often include the name of the local pastor and a legitimate looking email address. But a closer look should raise some red flags. For example, the email address isn't the one normally used by the church, and the service provider is different, too. The message may begin with a simple "Hi," but doesn't include a recipients' name. There also may be spelling errors, including the pastor's name.

The imposter asks you to buy a popular gift card — frequently, iTunes, Google Play, or Amazon — and then asks for the gift card number and PIN on the back of the card. Those numbers let the scammer immediately get the money you loaded onto the card. And once that's done, the scammer and your money are gone, usually without a trace.

If you or someone you know paid a scammer with a gift card, report it as soon as possible. Call the card company and tell them the gift card was used in a scam. Here is contact information for some of the gift card companies that scammers use most often. Then, tell the FTC about it at ftc.gov/complaint. Your reports may help law enforcement agencies launch investigations that could stop imposters and other fraudsters in their tracks.

We have students whose parents have lost their jobs and are worried about having enough food at home, students whose family members are essential workers and have gotten very sick, or kids whose grandparents who have passed away during this time. Our school district is doing the best we can to make sure our students' basic needs are being met, as well as providing emotional support to those whose families are going through especially stressful times or are grieving the loss of a loved one right now.

Thank you to all of my teachers at St. Germaine who encouraged me to speak up and rise up to meet challenges, and who laid the foundation for my education. I'm forever grateful to all of you! I also wanted to take the time to thank all teachers and essential workers who have been working so incredibly hard and helping so many. Amidst all the uncertainty and loss that people are experiencing, there are so many individuals and communities that are filling the world with hope and kindness. Whenever you have the chance to brighten someone's day or do something that might lighten someone's burden, even just a little bit, seize the moment. 




