A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Our lives are filled with questions. Today, as 2022 quickly nears an end and we prepare to welcome in 2023, more than ever we are worried, anxious and uncertain about life. When will I be able to find work? How will I provide food, clothing and health coverage for my family? When will the job market get better so I can find a job? At what age will I be able to retire? Our lives are constantly filled with questions; the answers we give can change the direction of our lives and the lives of our families.

If we could only be as certain in our answers as was John the Baptist when he cried out from the desert for the people to prepare the way of the Lord. Our answers to life's important questions are usually given with some, if not a lot, of anxiety. But John filled with the Holy Spirit, answered very readily and boldly by telling the people to treat everyone fairly, honestly, with respect and care. He was telling the people to prepare to welcome the Lord in their midst by welcoming each other in care and friendship. What should we do to prepare for the coming of Christ? We should listen to the words of John the Baptist and welcome one another in care and friendship as if we were welcoming the Lord himself, because we are welcoming the Lord, who makes his dwelling not only among us, but in each of our hearts.

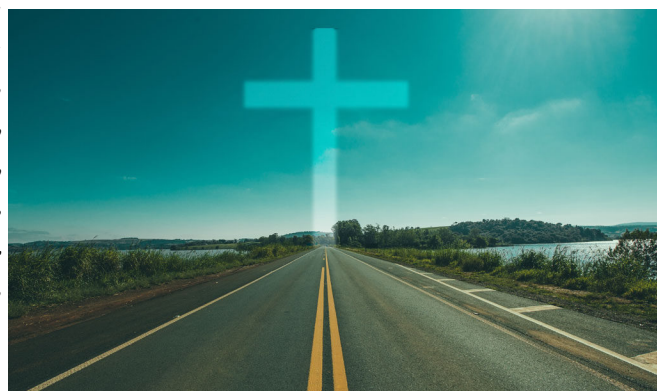

The Lord's Highway

Our theme for this Advent is "The Lord's Highway." The reading from the book of Isaiah on this first Sunday invites us to "climb the Lord's mountain," and to "walk in the light of the Lord." We know that the gospel message of John the Baptist is to "prepare the way of the Lord," and "make straight his path." The Psalms too speak of the joy of "going up to the house of the Lord." This Advent, we will reflect on our journey along the Lord's Highway. Like any journey, we look for the directions to reach our destination.

The season of Advent isn't really designed to be a countdown to the celebration of Christmas. Instead, it is a time of preparation for Christ's return and the establishment of the kingdom of God. It is a reminder that we are heading someplace; we are works in progress; we are longing for something more. That's the true call of Advent. At the same time, we are indeed looking back. We remember the Incarnation, when God broke into our history and became present in an astonishing way. We also look forward to when Emmanuel—God with us—will be how we live always.

We are traveling the Lord's Highway, this Advent and always. We may not yet be all that we can be; we may not have yet reached our destinations as the people of God, but we are on the way. We are a pilgrim people who are ready to be embraced by the Lord as we journey. Let's rejoice in our Advent journey even in the struggles of a difficult world, even as we pray for those who are hurting, who are grieving, who are lost and alone. We celebrate and are joyful because our journey along the Lord's Highway will bring us into the wondrous presence of the Lord.

(1) Extraordinary income is non-recurring income that should not be counted towards operations; rather it should be placed in a long-term capital replacement fund so that it is available for emergency or extraordinary capital expenses.

(2) Raise The Roof donations

(3) New roofs for church and gym, \$461,600.00 : OLL taxes, title, surveys and deeds, \$14,800.00

(4) As a side note, Our Lady of Loretto had \$80,790.00 in their To Teach Who Christ Is collection, which was able to contribute to the new roof projects since it could not be used for operational expenses.

Although the church ran a deficit, a good portion of it was from the Our Lady of Loretto campus : \$88,800.00
For Our Lady of Loretto alone, the utilities ran at \$33,700.00, building and grounds upkeep ran at \$10,300.00, property insurance was \$30,000.00, and taxes,title, surveys and deeds were \$14,800.00.
The sale of the property went through July 8th,2022, so that profit will be on next year's fiscal report.
Had this property sale gone through sooner, those \$88,800.00 in expenses would not have been incurred, leaving the parish in a profitable state of \$49, 897.00 before extraordinary expenses were needed.
