# A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

"Everyone", that's a word I hear a lot. Most often it doesn't mean "everyone"; it means "me." I think or believe this or that and so "everyone" else must also think or believe this way, and so I can use "everyone" to give credence, authority and strengthen to my way of thinking and acting.

We hear the apostles tell Jesus that, "everyone is looking for you." But, Jesus knew better, they were looking for him to perform signs, wonders, and miracles. But, when he took up the Cross on his shoulders, almost "everyone" disappeared from his side.

And, even though everyone was searching for Jesus to be healed, to be feed, to see him perform signs, wonders, and miracles; Jesus took time to be one with the Father in prayer.

We don't need "everyone" with us all the time, but; we do need Jesus with us and we need to be one with the Father through Christ.

In the middle of his extremely hectic public ministry, Jesus always finds time to go aside to a lonely place and pray and to be one with the Father. Today's Gospel tells us that it was "long before dawn" that he did this. It may have been his usual practice to pray early in the morning or he may have been restless after the events of the previous day and the thought of what lay ahead. Jesus provides us with a model of using prayer to reflect on events and to prepare ourselves for the day ahead to be with everyone who is looking for us.

We also do need each other, as followers of Jesus, our family and trusted friends. Together, with Christ at our side, we can win over "everyone" to Christ's way of thinking, acting, and praying.







#### HAVE YOU TRIED THE MANNA PROGRAM?

The Manna Program is one of the school's most successful fundraisers. Families that participate purchase gift cards from local vendors who rebate a portion of the purchase price to the school. For example, if a family purchases a \$100 Jewel card, they receive the full \$100. Jewel rebates about 4% to the school (\$4.00). So that rebate of 4% then gets split between the



school and the family. That can be used for tuition for School, Religious Education or high school tuition. Even if you try using it for groceries and gas, it would help out! The beauty of the program is that is provides "free money" from sources outside of the parish with no extra expenses to anyone. During the 2022-2023 school year, the total rebates from all vendors was \$25,860.00.

Manna certificates are sold weekdays in the school office. The program is open to everyone in the parish and provides a huge support to the school budget. For more information, contact the school office at 708-425-6063.


