

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Samuel the prophet was fast asleep when God called to him. Samuel the prophet did not recognize the voice of the Lord as he was being called into service and ministry. But we have, each one of us, been called into the Lord's service at the moment of our Baptism and again called into the service of the Lord and his people at Confirmation, called personally by name.

What exactly is this calling or mission that the Lord has set us aside for, as he did the prophet Samuel or the disciples? It is to help those around us find the Lord. It is to help others recognize the Lord's presence among us. It is to help them hear his voice calling to them.

This mission is fulfilled in us, not so much by effective words, but by our being an image and reflection of Christ. It is not an easy undertaking, but we are not alone. This is the mission of the entire Church of Christ, as his body, we support, pray for each other, and help each other see the Lord's presence among us. And of course, the Lord is with us, and he knows each of us by our name, so we can never escape from his voice.

Let us listen intently for his voice, whether it comes to in the middle of the night or through the voice of another; especially those in need, the weakest among us, and the most vulnerable in our midst.





HAVE YOU TRIED THE MANNA PROGRAM?



The Manna Program is one of the school's most successful fundraisers. Families that participate purchase gift cards from local vendors who rebate a portion of the purchase price to the school. For example, if a family purchases a \$100 Jewel card, they receive the full \$100. Jewel rebates about 4% to the school (\$4.00). So that rebate of 4% then gets split between the school and the family. That can be used for tuition for School, Religious Education or high school tuition. Even if you try using it for groceries and gas, it would help out! The beauty of the program is that it provides "free money" from sources outside of the parish with no extra expenses to anyone. During the 2022-2023 school year, the total rebates from all vendors was \$25,860.00.

Manna certificates are sold weekdays in the school office. The program is open to everyone in the parish and provides a huge support to the school budget. For more information, contact
