





Free Throw Rules: Each Player will take three warm up shots. Contest will be the Best of 10 free throws. Tie breaker will be best of 5 free throws followed by Best of 3 free throws (if necessary) until a

winner is established. Players must start and end the shots behind the **free throw** line.

Split-the-Pot Raffle Fact Sheet

Most of you may have already been using the additional orange envelope included for each week with your envelope package. For those of you who would like to participate, here are some details and answers to questions about this plan.

Why are we doing this? The main source of funding we need to operate Our Lady at St. Germaine parish is our Sunday collection. Sunday envelope usage provides us with a consistent and reliable means of tracking that income. Unfortunately, only about one third of our registered parishioners use their envelopes regularly. One reason for this plan is to provide an incentive to use Sunday envelopes regularly. Another reason is to raise funds for capital expenses (improvements and renovations to our facilities).

How does it work? Simply put, everyone who contributes a minimum of \$5.00 in their regular Sunday envelope and a minimum of \$5.00 in the orange split the pot envelope is eligible to win the prize for that week. Each week, a <u>potential</u> winner is drawn at random from <u>all</u> the registered parishioners (not just the contributors). Everyone's odds remain essentially the same from week to week. If the name drawn <u>has made</u> the required contributions in both envelopes for that week, he or she receives the prize money. If not, that week's prize is rolled over to the next week's drawing.

How much is the prize? The amount of the prize is equal to one half of the amount received in the orange envelopes for that week plus any rollover amount. So it will vary.

What happens to the other half of the orange envelope amount? The funds raised in the orange envelopes will be used for our parish capital expenses.

How will I know who wins? Each week the bulletin will publish the amount of the previous week's prize and envelope number (not the name) that was drawn and whether the prize was awarded or will be rolled over. (Remember in order to actually win the prize, the person had to make their contributions that week.)

What's with the "rollover"? The purpose of the "rollover" is to increase excitement and provide an added incentive to participate in subsequent weeks. If <u>everyone</u> participates there will be a winner every week (no rollover) and the prize will be over \$3,000.

What if I contribute regularly but only once a month (or bi-weekly)? If your regular parish monthly (or bi-weekly) contribution is equal to at least \$5.00 a week, you can still be eligible. Simply indicate on your envelope that your contribution is for the month or weeks ahead. Annual or semi-annual contributors will have to split their donation into at least twelve portions. (Our records will also show your pattern of contributions.) However, you must still use the orange envelope for each week you wish to participate. That's because the amount of each week's prize is based on the amount received in the orange envelopes.

What's the deadline? In order to be eligible for each week's prize, your contributions (both envelopes) must be turned in by Noon Monday. Anything received after that will count for the next week.

Won't some people just decrease their regular offering by the \$5.00 they put in the orange envelope? It is possible and in those cases we would lose the \$2.50 that goes into the prize. But the hope is that most of the regular contributors will simply kick in the extra \$5.00. Also, those who contribute less than \$10.00 a week may be encouraged to participate at least at that level.







Split-the-Pot Raffle Fact Sheet

Most of you may have already been using the additional orange envelope included for each week with your envelope package. For those of you who would like to participate, here are some details and answers to questions about this plan.

Why are we doing this? The main source of funding we need to operate Our Lady at St. Germaine parish is our Sunday collection. Sunday envelope usage provides us with a consistent and reliable means of tracking that income. Unfortunately, only about one third of our registered parishioners use their envelopes regularly. One reason for this plan is to provide an incentive to use Sunday envelopes regularly. Another reason is to raise funds for capital expenses (improvements and renovations to our facilities).

How does it work? Simply put, everyone who contributes a minimum of \$5.00 in their regular Sunday envelope and a minimum of \$5.00 in the orange split the pot envelope is eligible to win the prize for that week. Each week, a <u>potential</u> winner is drawn at random from <u>all</u> the registered parishioners (not just the contributors). Everyone's odds remain essentially the same from week to week. If the name drawn <u>has made</u> the required contributions in both envelopes for that week, he or she receives the prize money. If not, that week's prize is rolled over to the next week's drawing.

How much is the prize? The amount of the prize is equal to one half of the amount received in the orange envelopes for that week plus any rollover amount. So it will vary.

What happens to the other half of the orange envelope amount? The funds raised in the orange envelopes will be used for our parish capital expenses.

How will I know who wins? Each week the bulletin will publish the amount of the previous week's prize and envelope number (not the name) that was drawn and whether the prize was awarded or will be rolled over. (Remember in order to actually win the prize, the person had to make their contributions that week.)

What's with the "rollover"? The purpose of the "rollover" is to increase excitement and provide an added incentive to participate in subsequent weeks. If <u>everyone</u> participates there will be a winner every week (no rollover) and the prize will be over \$3,000.

What if I contribute regularly but only once a month (or bi-weekly)? If your regular parish monthly (or bi-weekly) contribution is equal to at least \$5.00 a week, you can still be eligible. Simply indicate on your envelope that your contribution is for the month or weeks ahead. Annual or semi-annual contributors will have to split their donation into at least twelve portions. (Our records will also show your pattern of contributions.) However, you must still use the orange envelope for each week you wish to participate. That's because the amount of each week's prize is based on the amount received in the orange envelopes.

What's the deadline? In order to be eligible for each week's prize, your contributions (both envelopes) must be turned in by Noon Monday. Anything received after that will count for the next week.

Won't some people just decrease their regular offering by the \$5.00 they put in the orange envelope? It is possible and in those cases we would lose the \$2.50 that goes into the prize. But the hope is that most of the regular contributors will simply kick in the extra \$5.00. Also, those who contribute less than \$10.00 a week may be encouraged to participate at least at that level.



I have truly enjoyed my time in the school with our students, families, teachers and staff. Our students are very welcoming, friendly, and respectful as our parents and the entire school staff.





Split-the-Pot Raffle Fact Sheet

Most of you may have already been using the additional orange envelope included for each week with your envelope package. For those of you who would like to participate, here are some details and answers to questions about this plan.

Why are we doing this? The main source of funding we need to operate Our Lady at St. Germaine parish is our Sunday collection. Sunday envelope usage provides us with a consistent and reliable means of tracking that income. Unfortunately, only about one third of our registered parishioners use their envelopes regularly. One reason for this plan is to provide an incentive to use Sunday envelopes regularly. Another reason is to raise funds for capital expenses (improvements and renovations to our facilities).

How does it work? Simply put, everyone who contributes a minimum of \$5.00 in their regular Sunday envelope and a minimum of \$5.00 in the orange split the pot envelope is eligible to win the prize for that week. Each week, a <u>potential</u> winner is drawn at random from <u>all</u> the registered parishioners (not just the contributors). Everyone's odds remain essentially the same from week to week. If the name drawn <u>has made</u> the required contributions in both envelopes for that week, he or she receives the prize money. If not, that week's prize is rolled over to the next week's drawing.

How much is the prize? The amount of the prize is equal to one half of the amount received in the orange envelopes for that week plus any rollover amount. So it will vary.

What happens to the other half of the orange envelope amount? The funds raised in the orange envelopes will be used for our parish capital expenses.

How will I know who wins? Each week the bulletin will publish the amount of the previous week's prize and envelope number (not the name) that was drawn and whether the prize was awarded or will be rolled over. (Remember in order to actually win the prize, the person had to make their contributions that week.)

What's with the "rollover"? The purpose of the "rollover" is to increase excitement and provide an added incentive to participate in subsequent weeks. If <u>everyone</u> participates there will be a winner every week (no rollover) and the prize will be over \$3,000.

What if I contribute regularly but only once a month (or bi-weekly)? If your regular parish monthly (or bi-weekly) contribution is equal to at least \$5.00 a week, you can still be eligible. Simply indicate on your envelope that your contribution is for the month or weeks ahead. Annual or semi-annual contributors will have to split their donation into at least twelve portions. (Our records will also show your pattern of contributions.) However, you must still use the orange envelope for each week you wish to participate. That's because the amount of each week's prize is based on the amount received in the orange envelopes.

What's the deadline? In order to be eligible for each week's prize, your contributions (both envelopes) must be turned in by Noon Monday. Anything received after that will count for the next week.

Won't some people just decrease their regular offering by the \$5.00 they put in the orange envelope? It is possible and in those cases we would lose the \$2.50 that goes into the prize. But the hope is that most of the regular contributors will simply kick in the extra \$5.00. Also, those who contribute less than \$10.00 a week may be encouraged to participate at least at that level.


