

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Jesus appointed seventy-two disciples to go in pairs before him to prepare the towns he intended to visit, by announcing his message of peace and expel demons.

This is how Jesus gathered his disciples and followers. This is how he gave them life, dignity, nourished them in mind, body, and spirit and raised them up. This is how Jesus touched their hearts and changed their lives forever. This is what Christ asks us do each Sunday in memory of him.

# Split The Pot Drawing




