

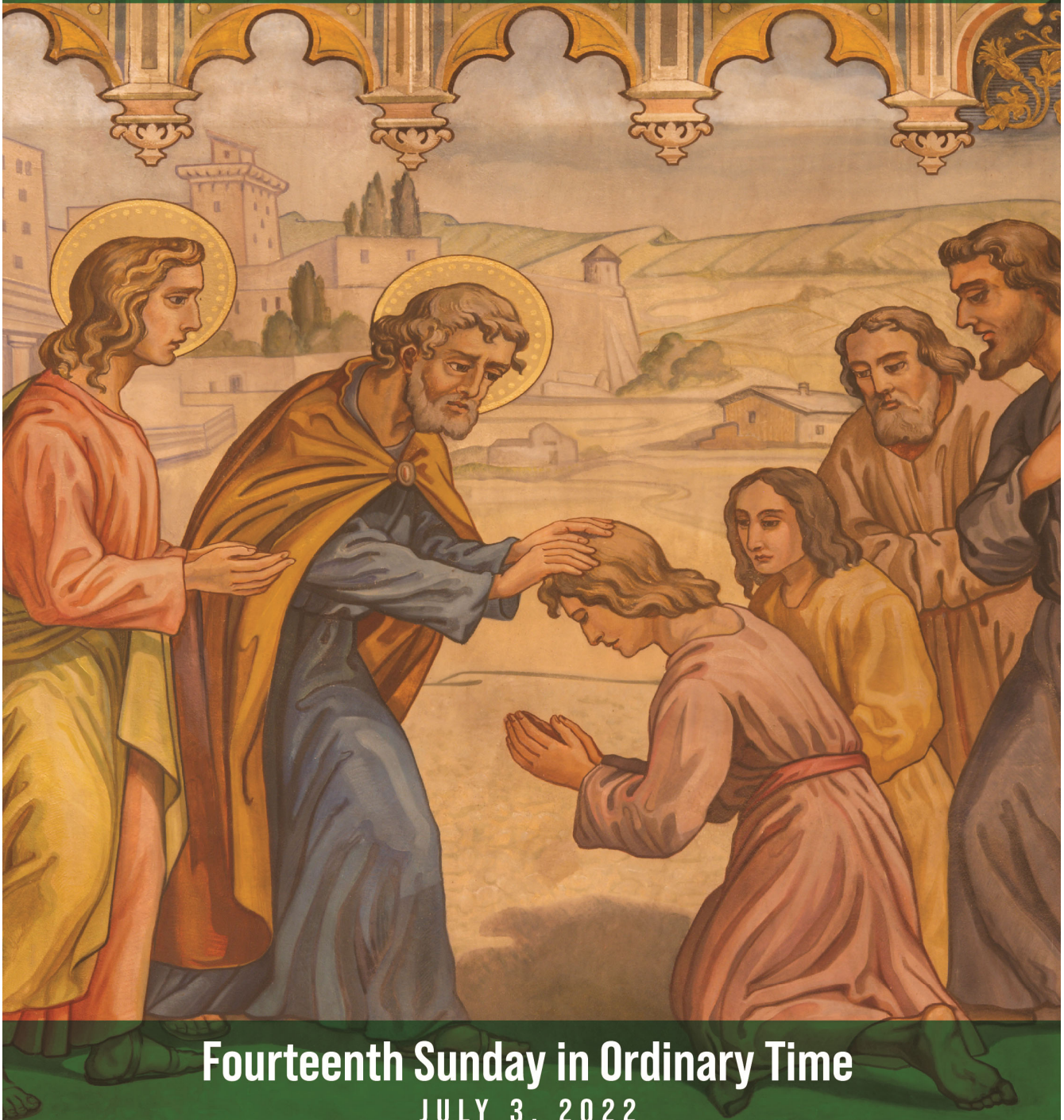

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Jesus appointed seventy-two disciples to go in pairs before him to prepare the towns he intended to visit, by announcing his message of peace and expel demons.

There are a lot of modern day demons that we face and experience as individuals and as a society that keep us from living in the Lord's peace. Most are very obvious and easily recognized and named by all of us. But, some demons are much more subtle in nature and we might even consider them as a society to be good and virtuous.

However, when we examine them closely, we come to realize that they keep us from the Lord and his peace; they keep us from our families and friends. What are some of the modern day demons of our lives and society that keep us from the Lord's peace?

One comes from today's technology which has fostered a lack of personal communications, conversation, and dialogue. While e-mails, text messaging, and the use of the cell phone has made communications quick, readily available, these tools of communications have also hampered the growth of developing interpersonal relationships. You may be able to learn a lot about a person from their postings on various internet sites, but can you really get to know a person from these means of communicating.

The best way of forming friendships, entering into true dialogue and meaningful relationships is through sitting at table with others and breaking bread with them. This is how Jesus gathered his disciples and followers. This is how he gave them life, dignity, nourished them in mind, body, and spirit and raised them up. This is how Jesus touched their hearts and changed their lives forever. This is what Christ asks us do each Sunday in memory of him.

Split The Pot Drawing



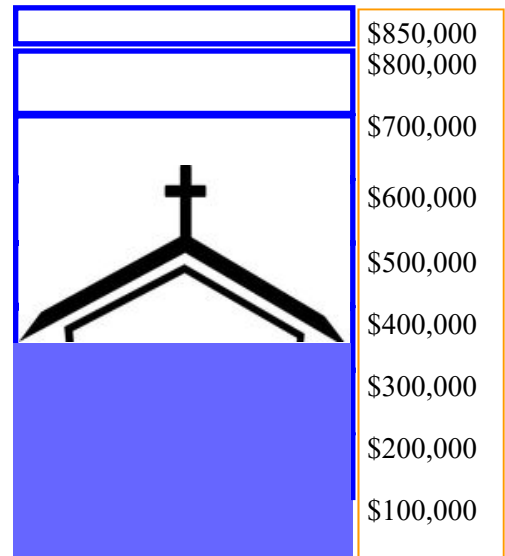
