A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

There are seven gifts given to us in the sacrament of Confirmation: wisdom, understanding, right judg-ment, courage, knowledge, love and reverence for God. These are the same gifts that the apostles re-ceived on Pentecost.

With the grace, blessings, and other gifts that the Holy Spirit gives us through these seven gifts, we must become the eighth gift of the Spirit to one another. Or, as today's Gospel states, we must be-come advocates, as the Holy Spirit is our Advocate.

An advocate is someone that defends or maintains the cause of another. An advocate is one that sup-ports or promotes the interests of another. We must especially support the weak, those who are hungry, and those who have no voice to speak for their wellbeing.

How many times have we been at the right place at the right time to be with someone or help someone? How many times did we have just the right words for someone that was hurting? How many times did a gift come into our lives that we were able to share with someone in need? It is the Holy Spirit at work in us giving us words of wisdom, understanding and loving hearts, and courage to enter into the lives of others who are in need of the gifts of the Lord in their lives.


