

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

This is Father George, writing this column this weekend, in place of Fr. Tom. I take this opportunity to officially announce that I am retiring from active ministry after 44 years of priesthood. It is time for rest and relaxation. First of all I want to thank each and everyone of you for making my stay here very enjoyable. I enjoyed the loving company and friendship of all of you. I have been here for the last seven years. It looks like a record because no associate has lasted that long. Every day of these 7 years has been very fulfilling and happy.

Lots of things have happened in the last 7 years. Former Pastor Fr. Mike Furlan retired 3 years ago and the new Pastor Fr. Tom Cabala took over the Parish after it merged with Our Lady of Loretto. By the way, I don't like the new name Our Lady at St. Germaine. I feel every parish should have a saint name found in the Roman Martyr-ology. It is a book that contains the names of all saints who were officially canonized by the Church or considered saints by popular acclamation as in the cases of martyrs of the ancient church. We must have a date set aside to celebrate the titular feast of this parish. It is only my personal view.

Now coming to the events that took place in the last 7 years. I moved out of the church rectory, so that it could be sold to finance the roofing of the church. A new capital campaign to raise funds for capital improvements of the parish buildings. A new principal is ready to take over the school, replacing Kevin Reedy who after decades of service as a principal retires and many more changes. But what is important is that in the face of all these changes, the parishioners have stood strong. So I am proud of you and extremely grateful to you all.

Now, as for what you think of me, is something you get to tell me. Every priest is a shepherd. Have I been a good shepherd? Have I been faithful to my duty as a good shepherd? Did I lead you on the right path? Have I helped you to grow closer to our good shepherd, Jesus Christ? You are the judge. I know I have not been perfect. I have failed on several respects. I have not been my best to you a lot of times. I apologize for all my failures and lack of interest and enthusiasm. If one of you has been touched by my words, if at least one of you has found solace in my comforting words, if one of you has a conversion of heart to the Lord Jesus, if one of you has had a good and happy death because of my presence by his or her bedside, if at least one of you has gotten closer to the Lord. . . . I am grateful and happy. My life is fulfilled.

Once again a Big THANK YOU from the very bottom of my heart. May God Bless you all! Keep me in your prayers and I promise to continue my prayers for you.

Fr. Tom's Article....

What does it mean to love one another as Christ loved us?

St. Paul describes it best in his letter to the Corinthians, when he writes:

Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, is not pompous, it is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things. (1 Cor. 13: 3-7)

This is the love that Christ lived and enabled him to die on the Cross for the salvation of the world.

St. Paul believed that Jesus gave his life in love for the salvation of all humanity. The superior attitude and selfishness of the Corinthians however, prevented them from sharing in salvation unless their thinking and behavior changed and they became reflections of Christ's unconditional love in their own lives. To share in the resurrection of Christ and his promise of eternal life and love means to have the same self-emptying love in imitation of Jesus with all people not just those of equal social positions, wealth, and status.

It is the mission of every one of us as members of the body of Christ, his Church to be reflections of Christ's life giving and unselfish love by coming to the Lord's Table, the Eucharist, prepared to welcome the Lord into our hearts, because we have welcomed one another to our everyday tables in a love that is kind, patient, and caring.





Fees

The following fees, established by the Athletic Association, will be required once the season is given clearance. Fees will be due before the first practice date.

4th - 8th Grade

\$150 league registration fee per player

\$400 family participation fee, **which can be recouped** for work in the concession stand, front door, or gym supervisor. This will be a separate check for this fee.

Uniform fee - All new players must order a uniform. Returning players may wear the previous year's uniform. Each player should have a full uniform in good condition; this includes both a team jersey and uniform shorts. A complete basketball uniform costs \$75.

3rd Grade - \$60 fee. This will cover the league fee and a uniform T-Shirt.

There will also be a mandatory parent & player meeting before the season starts at a date and time TBD. The meeting will cover the season details, parent participation, and sportsmanship.


