

A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

Jesus said to his disciples: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." And, because of his love for us, Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit to teach us and guide us in loving one another as Jesus himself loves us.

We live in Christ's love when we keep his commandments. But, to truly love as Christ loves means often going beyond keeping the commandments; it means sacrificing and going beyond our obligations to the commandments. Today's Gospel emphasizes the link between love and obedience. Jesus calls for a love that is as self-sacrificing as his own. Obedience to God's commandments is not a requirement for love; it is the end result of loving as Christ loves us.

Just as the disciples were motivated by Christ's love and so they respond to Jesus in obedience, so if we call ourselves followers of Christ we must practice that same kind of love by being obedient to God's commandments, but, also reach out to others and going beyond what the commandments expect of us.

Last week envelope #154 was drawn and did not participate in the drawing. The amount of \$3,015.00 will be added to next weeks pot.



Fees

The following fees, established by the Athletic Association, will be required once the season is given clearance. Fees will be due before the first practice date.

4th - 8th Grade

\$150 league registration fee per player

\$400 family participation fee, **which can be recouped** for work in the concession stand, front door, or gym supervisor. This will be a separate check for this fee.

Uniform fee - All new players must order a uniform. Returning players may wear the previous year's uniform. Each player should have a full uniform in good condition; this includes both a team jersey and uniform shorts. A complete basketball uniform costs \$75.

3rd Grade - \$60 fee. This will cover the league fee and a uniform T-Shirt.

There will also be a mandatory parent & player meeting before the season starts at a date and time TBD. The meeting will cover the season details, parent participation, and sportsmanship.


