

- (1) Extraordinary income is <u>non-recurring</u> income that should <u>not</u> be counted towards operations; rather it should be placed in a long-term capital replacement fund so that it is available for emergency or extraordinary capital expenses.
- (2) The original net sale proceeds from the OLL property sale was \$1,218,768 and if you back out the loan debt recovered by the diocese of \$535,985 it leaves the parish with \$682,783. Our Raise the Roof campaign brought in \$86,689, with one more year to go. To Teach Who Christ donations are wrapping up with a total of \$1,710.
 (\$682,783 + \$86,689 + 1,710 = \$771,182)
- (3) Church and gym roofs replaced, sinking sewers repaired, TTWCI money was diverted to increase security measures for the school, final land survey and real estate taxes on the OLL property
- (4) Additional money needed to help fund security cameras and fix school doors.
