

### A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

We celebrate the Feast of Christ the King. Different from any earthly king, Christ kingship is defined from the Old Testament understanding of king as shepherd. We know well from the Scriptures that the shepherd kings of Israel were anointed by God to be protectors and servants of their people, even laying down their lives for their people, as Christ did for us.

The Church year comes to an end as we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King, the readings speak of the signs that point to Christ's Second coming in glory. People look to the distant stars and planets, to the heavens, for signs of Christ's coming, forgetting that he is already present among us. And so, we must make them aware that Christ is among us by ourselves being signs of light, peace, and compassion. Our personal involvement in the lives of the poor, the sick, and those hurting in so many different ways is the sign that society needs to see in order to understand that Christ is already among us.

You have often heard me speak of our mission as followers of Christ to become images of Christ; yes, kings, but not as we understand kingship or queen ship from observing earthly royalty. Our kingship, as is Christ's kingship comes from the Old Testament, the Hebrew Scriptures understanding or kingship. The kings that lead the Hebrew people lead as shepherds, who were willing to lay down their lives for their people; just as Christ laid down his life for us on the Cross.

We must also be shepherds to one another in the likeness of Christ as we share our time, gifts and talents to build up our parish and through our parish of Our Lady at St. Germaine, build the kingdom of God here on earth.



### **Oplatki Christmas Tradition**

The tradition of the Oplatki originated in Poland during Early Christian Times. This Christmas custom began with a simple white wafer, baked from flour and water. The wafers are wonderfully designed to display Christmas images, such as the Nativity. The Oplatki are enjoyed by families, typically right before the Christmas Eve meal. The entire family will gather around the table with the Oplatki.


Generally the eldest member of the family will begin the ritual by breaking off a piece of the wafer and passing it to another family member with a blessing.

This blessing can simply consist of what you desire for your loved one in the upcoming year – whether it be good health, success, or happiness.

The purpose of this act is primarily to express one's unconditional love and forgiveness for each member of his or her family. The significance of the Oplatki Christmas wafer is that it shadows the Eucharistic meal that Catholics participate in at each Mass. Just as we share in the Eucharist as one family in Christ and receive Christ's love through the Eucharist, the Oplatki allows for one's immediate family to come together and share love for one another. Although this tradition is primarily enjoyed by the human members of the family, even the family pets can partake in this meal.

Whereas the wafers are generally white in color, there are colored Oplatki made especially for pets although both colors are edible by people. Traditionally, this symbolizes the animals that were present at Christ's birth. However, in current times, this can also represent the important role that pets play in the family. The Oplatki tradition is one that is easy and fun to introduce to the family at Christmas time. All it requires is a simple wafer paired with love and affection, and the willingness to share it. This is a heartwarming tradition that will complete your family's time together during the Christmas season.
