SIMBANG GABI is a devotional nine-day series of Masses attended by Filipino Catholics in anticipation of Christmas. Simbang Gabi originated in the early days of Spanish rule over the Philippines, around 1669, as a practical compromise for farmers who began work in the fields before sunrise to avoid the noonday heat. Priests began to say Mass in the early mornings instead of evening novenas that were more common in the rest of the Hispanic world. This cherished Christmas custom eventually became a distinct feature of Philippine culture, community and sharing.

Our parish will host one of the Simbang Gabi novena Masses this Advent on Friday, December 16 at 7pm. Mark your calendars and join us for this joyful celebration as we wait in hope for the coming of our Savior's birth.






