A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Parish Family of Our Lady at St. Germaine,

How would you feel if you had done a full day's work and were paid the same as someone who had only worked for one hour? Is the landowner in the parable being unjust? He pays the workers exactly what he promised them—but he promised everyone the same amount, regardless of when they started work. The workers who started at 6:00am complain. How do you think the workers who started later in the day felt? The landowner claims the right to be generous - is generosity unfair?

Our God is generous beyond our imagination, but, his ways are also beyond our imagining. We often try to dictate how God should act and behave, according to our feelings, our ways of acting and behaving.

Our God is so much greater than anything we could ask or imagine. We are constantly surprised at how he turns our expectations, our fears and predictions upside down. We constantly look for God in the big and spectacular and he comes to us poor and hungry. God speaks through the most surprising people at the most surprising times.

But, we only need to look to Christ to realize God's ways, not our ways. How many of us can act and behave as Christ? Sacrificing, putting all of humanity before himself, dying on the Cross for us is contrary to the ways of human nature. They are God's ways. They are acts of holiness. The holiness we seek as we come each Sunday to be nourished in Word and Sacrament by Christ, that we may be images of him.

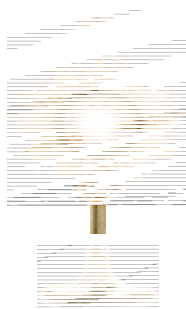

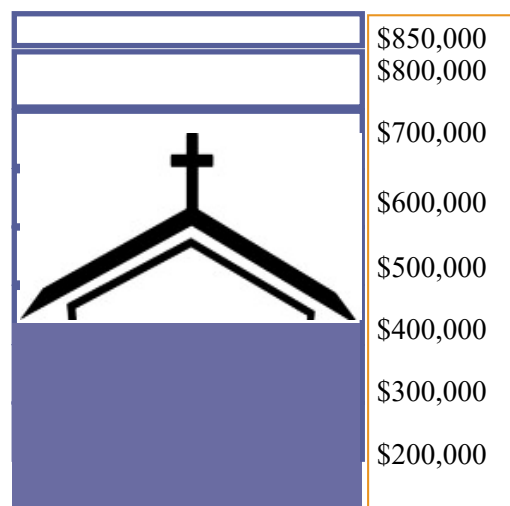

HAVE YOU TRIED THE MANNA PROGRAM?

The Manna Program is one of the school's most successful fundraisers. Families that participate purchase gift cards from local vendors who rebate a portion of the purchase price to the school. For example, if a family purchases a \$100 Jewel card, they receive the full \$100. Jewel rebates about 4% to the school (\$4.00). So that rebate of 4% then gets split between the school and the family. That can be used for tuition for School, Religious Education or high school tuition. Even if you try using it for groceries and gas, it would help out! The beauty of the program is that it provides "free money" from sources outside of the parish with no extra expenses to anyone. During the 2022-2023 school year, the total rebates from all vendors was \$25,860.00.



Manna certificates are sold throughout the summer from 9:00am until 12:00pm in the school office on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays. The office will be closed the week of July 4th. The program is open to everyone in the parish and provides a huge support to the school budget. For more information, contact the school office at 708-425-6063.

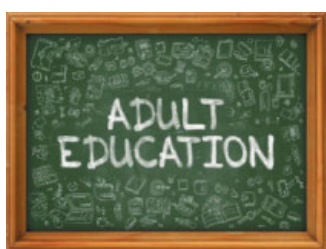


Renaissance Chicago NFP at St. Xavier University invites those 55+ to continue learning, sharing, and enjoying life.

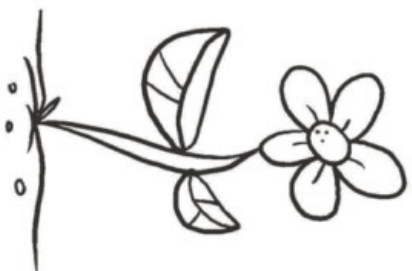
